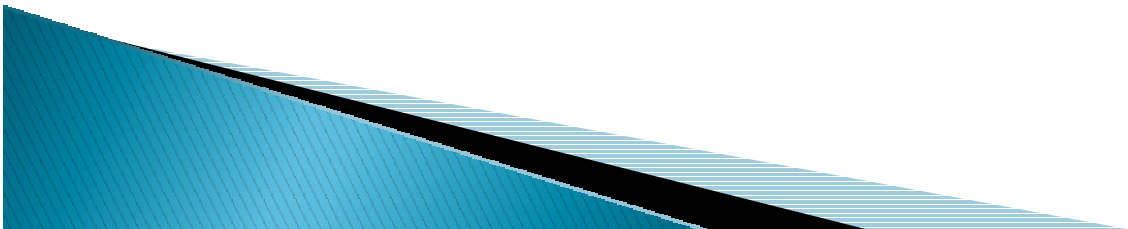

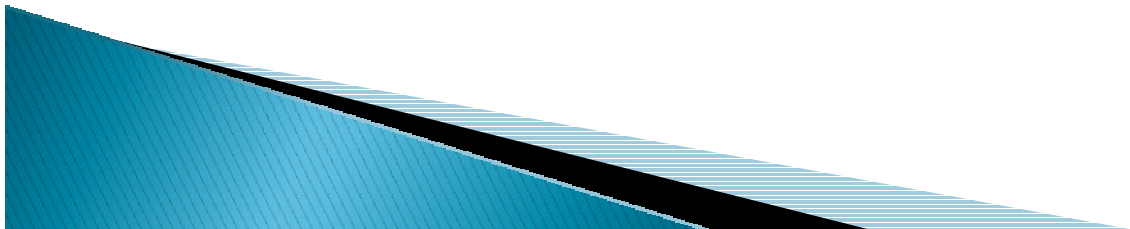
Priorities

Develop, Engage and Retain Members

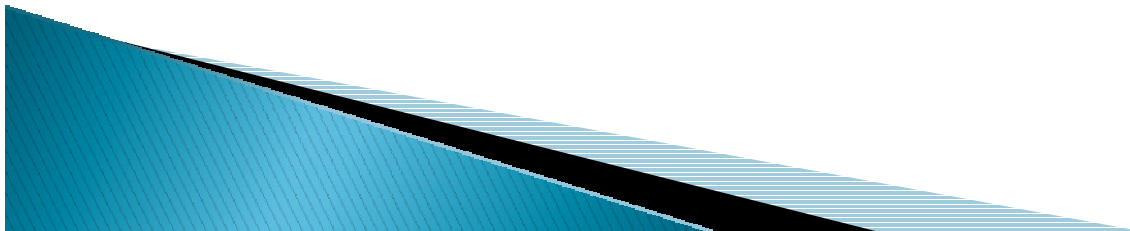

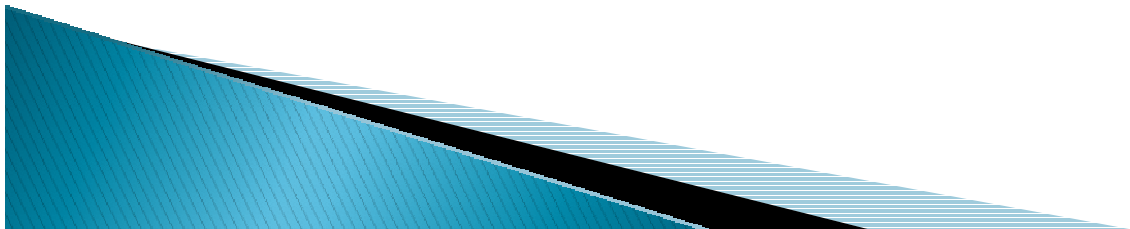

Develop Effective & Integrated Service Projects

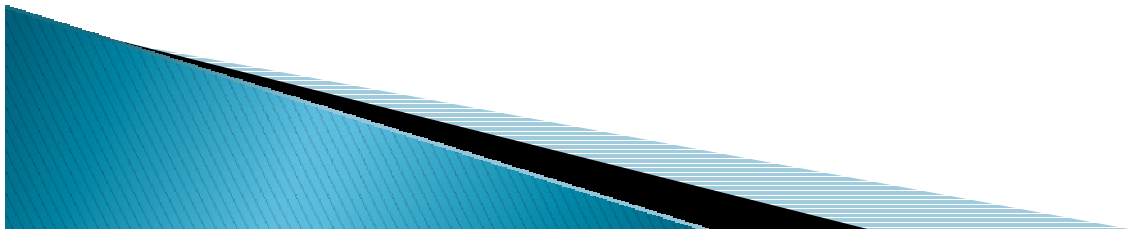

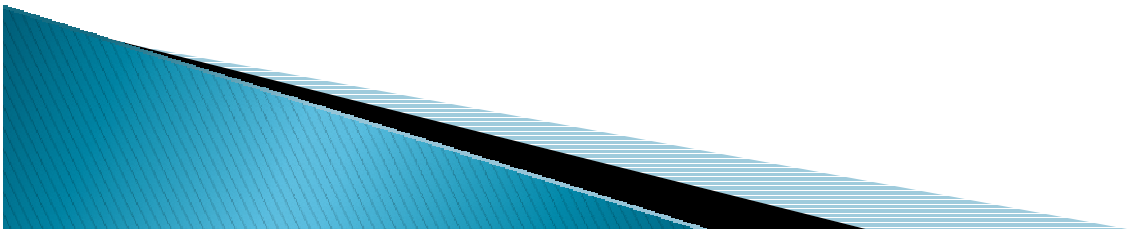
Foster Effective and Vibrant Clubs

 - ❖ Innovative Kin Kolleges



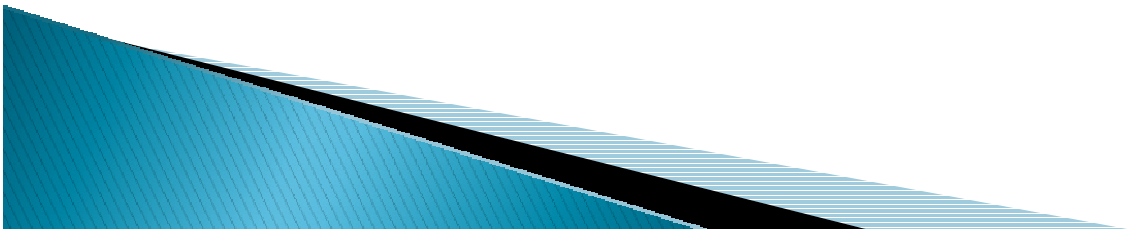
Other Priorities
