Members Achievement Award

This award is designed to be considered the highest award at the club level and will be recognized as such by all members.

Rules:

A Member Achievement Award can be presented to any past or present member of any club in the Association. A Member Achievement Award shall be granted as follows:

A Member Achievement Award committee shall be set up in the club, each member of the committee having 7 years or more membership years in the club. The committee will receive nominations and submit not more than three names to the club president and executive for approval. In situations where there are not three members with 7 years, names from other clubs may be submitted.

2. The MAA committee will present the candidates' names to the president and executive for approval at an executive meeting, if approved the president will announce the MAAs at a general meeting. The membership will then vote by secret ballot.

3. To qualify the member must have been a member in good standing for 7 years, and served his or her club, community and Association to the best of his or her ability.

4. The maximum number of MAAs awarded in any club is two per year if the club has over twenty members or one MAA per year if the club has fewer than twenty members. However, in special circumstances the Zone Executive may permit more members elected to the MAA.

5. Club MAAs cannot be transferred.

6. The MAA Committee will submit the MAA report form to National Headquarters and this information will be placed in the club's/member's file.
