Goals: Communication

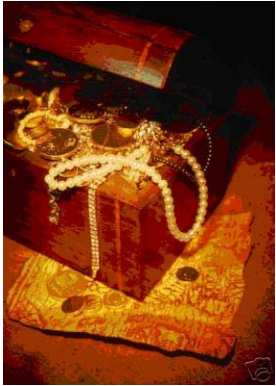


- Bylaws reviewed and updated then circulated immediately
